## Winter School Details

**Venue:** We will be holding the winter school at our Ebony Park venue. A map is available here: [www.wearegrowing.org/contacts/map](http://www.wearegrowing.org/contacts/map)

**Week 1:** tutors should take note which fundamentals the learners are really struggling with in maths in order to inform our Maths Fundamentals lectures in week 2.

**Brazil Youth Group:** We are hoping to connect with a youth group from Brazil over skype. We will need: reliable (decent speed) internet connection, a webcam and a mic. We may need to split the IY group as it may be too big.

**Soccer World Cup:** We will be screening the Bafana vs France game on a BIG SCREEN at our centre during the soccer world cup.

**Volunteers:** We need volunteers for help with the fundamental English and Maths Sessions as well as for: Tutoring, Career Guidance and Mentoring, Computer Literacy, and Creative Expression Programmes

**Transport:** Transport from Wits every morning at 8am leaving from the Wits bottom gate and returning at 5pm

**Poetry Session:** Students will be looking at slam poetry/ spoken word poetry examples from the web eg Saul Williams. We are hoping to get the SA slam poem champion Nhlanhla Buthelezi to come along. The students will then be introduced to a book of poetry (its incredible!) called Thebuwa written by Soweto school kids and some other performance poems to practice from, then drafting their own! It will end with our own open mike/poetry slam! There will also be a hip-hop component to this section

**Art:** The students will be creating their own graphic novel/comic autobiographies. They will be shown different examples of autobiographies and graphic novels comics (if any of the volunteers have please bring along!!) The cover will be a self portrait. . They will do an exploration of the meaning of their name as the next activity and then launch into the drawing of the graphic novel itself!

**Drama:** The students will be following Augusto Boal's forum theatre and creating their own pieces dealing with social issues such as gender issues, xenophobia etc. These will be performed in a way that encourages interaction with the audience

**Photography:** Students will be given digital cameras and will be constructing photo diaries of life in the township. Possibly also looking to connect to Google Earth applications

**IkamvaCares:** Students will identify a need in their community and come up with a plan for addressing this need as change-agents and beginner social-entrepreneurs. They will then come up with a solution to get the wider IkamvaYouth group involved.
